The Al Sweady Inquiry

RESTRICTION ORDER [Documents: Hearing 21.6.10]

UPON HEARING Counsel to the Inquiry and Counsel for the Ministry of Defence

AND UPON READING the application of the Ministry of Defence dated 18th June 2010 (“the MoD application”)

IT IS ORDERED that until further order:

1. This order binds all persons (whether acting by themselves or by their servants or agents or in any other way) and all companies (whether acting by their directors or officers, servants or agents or on any other way).
2. None of the documents the subject of the MoD application is to be disclosed other than in accordance with the terms of paragraph 3 of the MoD application, namely that the documents are to be shown (but not handed over) only to Iraqi Nationals who are being interviewed by the Inquiry and their lawyers and only to the extent that the documents relate to them.
3. Without prejudice to any further application under S19 of the Inquiries Act 2005 that may be made by the Ministry of Defence in respect of any of the documents that are the subject of this application and pursuant to s19(3) of the Inquiries Act 2005, there shall be no disclosure or publication of any of the information identified in the Ministry of

Defence's "Redaction Schedule for 18th June 2010" insofar as it falls within Categories 1, 2, 3 or 5.

4. The application relating to information identified as coming within Category 4 is adjourned generally.
